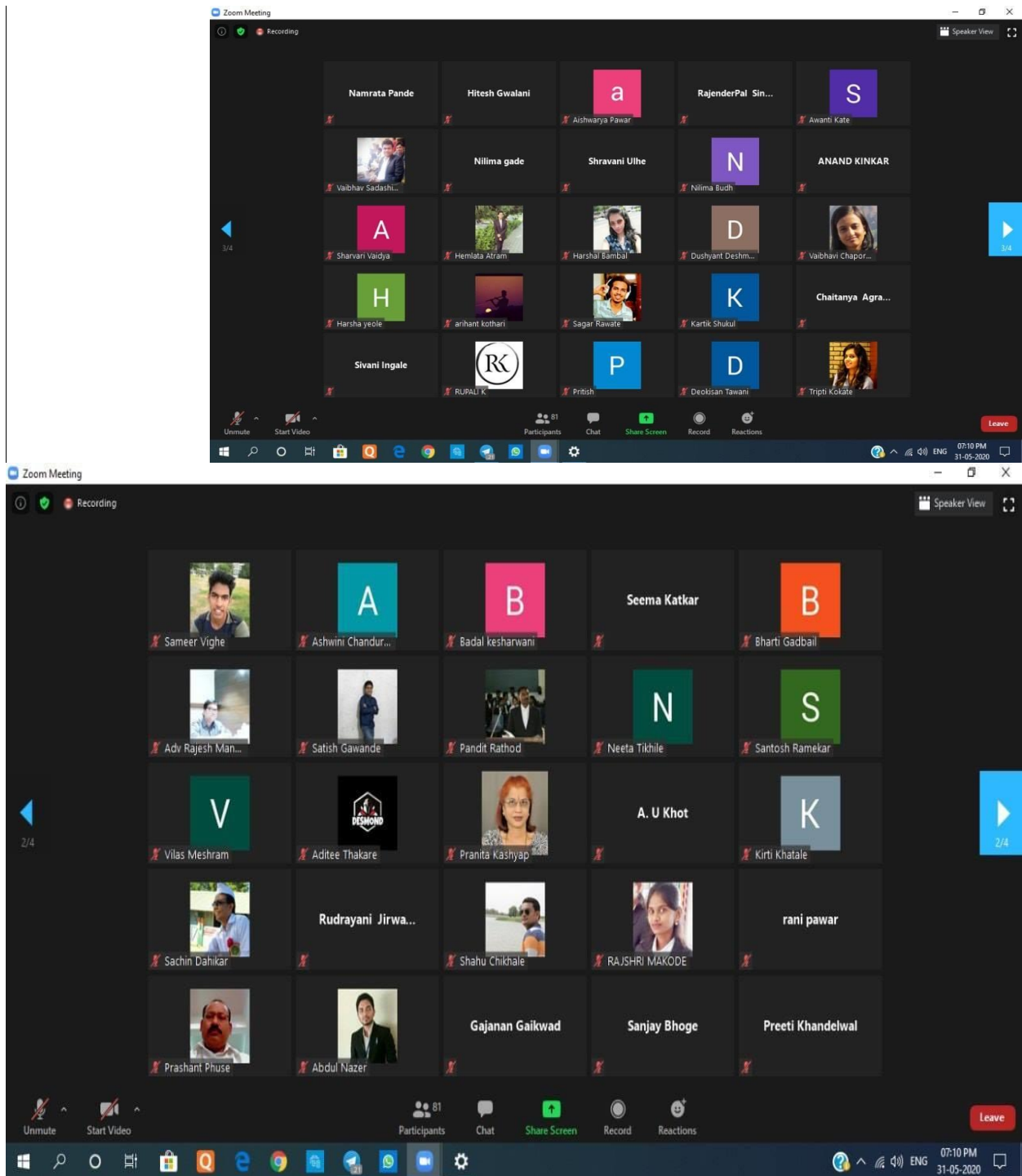

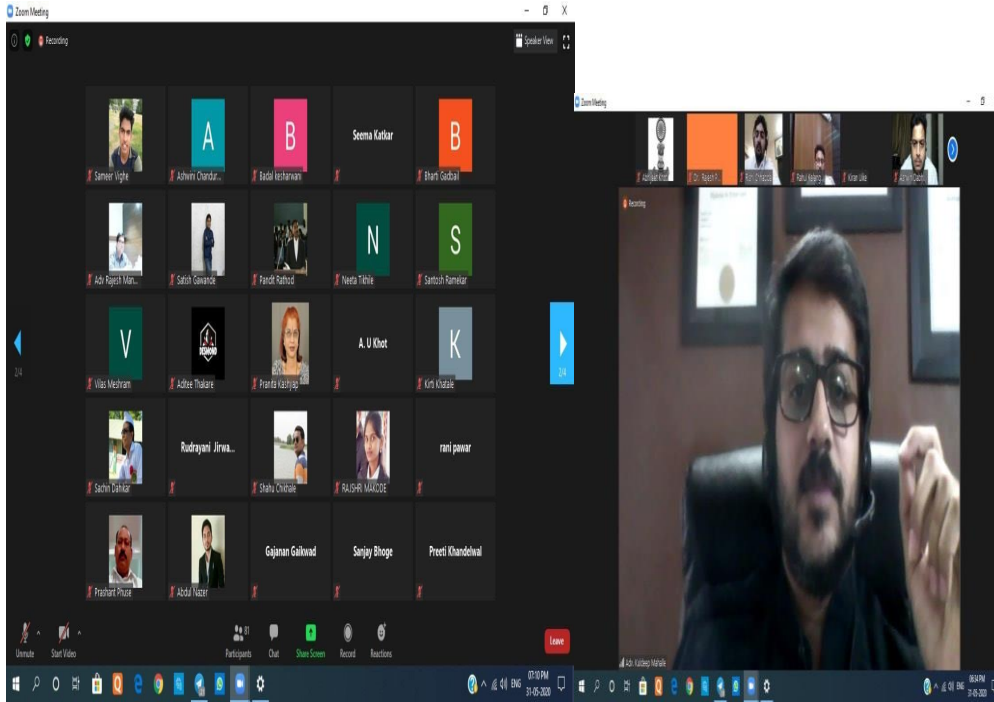

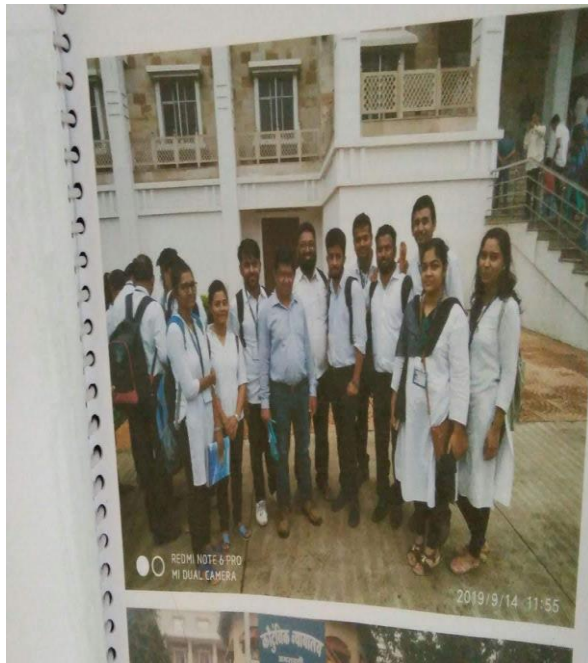

As a part of **experiential learning** the students are also encouraged to be a part of **legal aid clinic** of the institute. It helps and gives them experience in regards interviewing and counselling of the client, proper advice along with solution to be given to the client by analysing the legal provisions applicable to the problem in hand.

So also, regular visits to **Jail, Lok Adalat** , different courts are conducted for the students so as to help them observe and learn practically.

The Institute also promotes **participative learning** by encouraging students to actively participate in **classroom discussions, group activities, and debates**. This not only helps them to understand the subject matter better but also enables them to develop their critical thinking and communication skills.
