Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh College of Law was introduced as a faculty in 1946 as a part of Shri Shivaji College, Amravati. The growth and progress resulted in the separation of law faculty into an independent law college from the Academic Year 1978-79 onwards this college is affiliated to Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University

and Re-Accredited by NAAC 'B', Today the college has independent building since 1996. The new campus of the college is situated in a sprawling premises on Morshi Road, Amravati nearer to District Court, Collector Office, Commissioner Office, Bus Stand & Railway Station. The students of this college have brought many laurels to the institution in a curricular and extra curricular activities. The Legal Aid Clinic attached to the college is one of the most successfully clinic in the State of Maharashtra.

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh College of Law is a first law college in Amravati region serving and educating the masses since independence. The college has given thousands of lawyers, hundreds of judges who as social engineers are serving the society. The college conducts the under graduate course of LL.B. (Bachelor of Legum Laws) which is of 3 years duration having an intake capacity of 300 students & LL.B. 5 year duration having an intake capacity of 180 seats and College is running two years post graduate Degree Course in Law. (LL.M.) in the Five specialization with an intake capacity of 25 students per subject.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING

The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping/ forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.
- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
- i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

(Under section 26 (1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956)

In view of the directions of the Hon'ble Supreme Court in the matter of "University of Kerala v/s. Council, Principals, Colleges and others" and in consideration of the determination of the Central Government and the university Grants Commission to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging, the University Grants Commission has made "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009".

CONCESSION FOR ECONOMICALLY BACKWARD CLASS STUDENTS
