The new campus of the college is situated in a sprawling premises on Morshi Road, Amravati nearer to District Court, Collector Office, Commissioner Office, Bus Stand & Railway Station. The students of this college have brought many laurels to the institution in a curricular and extra curricular activities. The Legal Aid Clinic attached to the college is one of the most successfully clinic in the State of Maharashtra.

Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh College of Law is a first law college in Amravati region serving and educating the masses since independence. The college has given thousands of lawyers, hundreds of judges who as social engineers are serving the society. The college conducts the under graduate course of LL.B. (Bachelor of Legum Laws) which is of 3 years duration having an intake capacity of 300 students & LL.B. 5 year duration having an intake capacity of 180 Seats and College is running two years post graduate Degree Course in Law. (LL.M.) in the Five specialization with intake capacity of 25 students per subject.

2. As per university Ord. No. 3, it is compulsory for all the students to appear in the physical efficiency test which is usually held in the month of January or February. Any Failure on students' part shall invite disciplinary action.
3. All the students of the college are required to present themselves for a medical examination. Those failing to turn up for the test on the schedule day will have to get themselves examined by paying a specified fine or else they may face disciplinary action.

Students must take active part in various games and youth festivals planned by the college or University. Students are also encouraged to take part in Inter Collegiate Competitions from time to time.

RULES OF LIBRARY :

ADMISSION RULES

How to Apply

1. Application for admission is to be made in the prescribed form available at the college office on payment of prescribed charges in cash only.
2. Incomplete or defective application are liable to be rejected.
3. Attested true copies of Marklists, Migration Certificate if necessary, Transfer Certificate, Caste Certificates two passport size photograph and all other relevant documents are to be enclosed / attached with the application form.
4. Original documents are necessarily to be verified by the admission committee at the time of admission.
5. Selection and admission of candidates are made in accordance with the norms laid down by the Government, Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University, Bar Council of India and the Management of Shri Shivaji Education Society, Amravati and state Government.
6. The Merit list will be published on the college notice board according to the availability of seats.
7. The applicants shall make it convenient to take admission within the date announced along with the merit list.
8. If an applicant fails to take admission within the stipulated date announced by the admission committee ipso facto, he / she forfeits the chance for admission.
9. If admission is given at the time of the interview, the applicant may confirm it forthwith on payment of the prescribed fees.
10. All admissions will be provisional subject to the verification of original certificates, documents and the approval of the Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University and Bar Council of India.
11. On securing admission the original transfer certificate is to be surrendered for the college. T.C. will be given only after payment of due.
12. Admitted students who wish to apply for fee concession scholarship of any kind shall submit relevant documents in the college office for verification of the competent authority.

13. The applicant / Student of other University are duty bound to produce equivalence certificate from Sant Gadge Baba Amravati University to confirm their admission, failing which they are not entitled for admission.
 14. In the event of any additional requirement or compliance, the Principal shall publish notice on the board and the same shall have to be complied with by all students.
 15. Including above MHCET rule shall apply to admission process.
 16. Eligible candidates should apply for scholarship as per entitlement.

1. IDENTITY CARD

Every student is required to attach a passport size photo to the Identity Card, and on Application form for admission.

2. E.B.C. CONCESSION

E.B.C Concession if required, application in the prescribed form shall have to be presented in the College along with admission form at the time of admission.

3. SCHOLARSHIPS AND E.B.C. CONCESSION

Information in respect of different scholarship and E.B.C. concession is as per annexure 'A' appended to the prospectus. The annexure 'A' is subject to correction or deletions as per rules and order of University and Govt.

4. RE-ADMISSION OF STUDENTS

Students, whose name is stuck off from College Roll for non payment of requisite fee in scheduled time or for any other reason, could be considered for readmission on payment of full College dues with described readmission fees.

5. If any students leave the College during the session he shall be liable to make payments on account of College dues in full and the College shall have the authority to recover the same.

6. Balance dues on account of College fee etc. shall have to be paid by the students before the prescribed date of filling of University Examination forms.

7. ATTENDANCE

As per University Rules 80% attendance in each subject is essential and less attendance will result on E.B.C. Concession and such students will be required to make the payments of tuition fee in the particular quarter, Similarly less attendance than 75% the students shall not be eligible for appearing at University annual examination. Respective teacher shall look after the same.

CONCESSION FOR ECONOMICALLY BACKWARD CLASS STUDENTS

1. Economically Backward class students should submit their E.B.C. Concession form along with income certificate; the income should be for the period as per direction by authorities.
2. Students below 18 years of age shall submit E.B.C. forms signed by their Guardians / Parents only.
3. For eligibility of E.B.C. concession, it is obligatory for the student to have 80% attendance in each subject monthly, in default students will not be eligible for E.B.C. concession and they would be required to pay the tuition fee for the particular quarter.
4. Those parents who have signed the application form for admission would sign, the E.B.C form.
5. Acknowledgments of submission of E.B.C. form in the college is to be obtained from the office.
6. Court affidavit for gap period (break in education) is essential for E.B.C. Concession at the time of submission the E.B.C. form.

Note : All other details are notified on college notice board and students to contact office scholarship desks for various available scholarships.



Rules of Discipline

The college disciplinary rules are given below. The violation of any rule by any student will constitute the breach of discipline and the wrongdoers will be dealt with disciplinary action which may be in terms of fine or expulsion from the college.

1. To be regular and punctual in attending classes they should always come in the college with identity card and in Dress Code.
2. Maintain discipline and peaceful atmosphere.

Anti Ragging Rules

Ragging in any form within the campus or outside the campus is strictly prohibited by law. Any student who indulge actively or passively in the ragging act or abet the act of ragging and if found guilty of ragging is liable to be proceeded against under UGC Regulations On Curbing The Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions 2009, and Indian penal Code or any other law for the time being in force and such action would include but is not limited to detriment or expulsion of such student.

UGC REGULATIONS ON CURBING THE MENACE OF RAGGING IN HIGHER EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS, 2009.

(Under section 26 (1) (g) of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956)

In view of the directions of the **Hon'ble Supreme Court** in the matter of "**University of Kerala v/s. Council, Principals, Colleges and others**" and in consideration of the determination of the Central Government and the university Grants Commission to prohibit, prevent and eliminate the scourge of ragging, the University Grants Commission has made "Regulations on Curbing the Menace of Ragging in Higher Educational Institutions, 2009".

According to that, Ragging constitutes one or more of any of the following acts (As per Section 3)

- a) Any conduct by any student or students whether by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness a fresher or any other student.
- b) Indulging in rowdy or in disciplined activities by any student or students which causes or is likely to causes annoyance, hardship, physical or psychological harm or to raise fear or apprehension thereof in any fresher or any other student.
- c) Asking any student to do any act which such student will not in the ordinary course do and which has the effect of causing or generating a sense of shame, or torment or embarrassments so as to adversely affect the physique or psyche of such fresher or any other student.
- d) Any act by a senior student that prevents, disrupts or disturbs the regular academic activity of any other student or a fresher.
- e) Exploiting the services of a fresher or any other student for completing the academic tasks assigned to an individual or a group of students.
- f) Any act of financial extortion or forceful expenditure burden put on a fresher or any other student by students.
- g) Any act of physical abuse including all variants of it: sexual abuse, homosexual assaults, stripping/ forcing obscene and lewd acts, gestures, causing bodily harm or any other danger to health or person.

- h) Any act or abuse by spoken words, emails, post, public insults which would also include deriving perverted pleasure, vicarious or sadistic thrill from actively or passively participating in the discomfiture to fresher or any other student.
 - i) Any act that affects the mental health and self-confidence of a fresher or any other student with or without an intent to derive a sadistic pleasure or showing off power, authority or superiority by a student over any fresher or any other student.

ADMINISTRATIVE ACTION IN THE EVENT OF RAGGING

The Anti-Ragging Committee may, depending on the nature and gravity of the guilt established by the Anti-Ragging Squad, award, to those found guilty, one or more of the following punishments, namely:

- Suspension from attending classes and academic privileges.
- Withholding/ withdrawing scholarship/ fellowship and other benefits.
- Debarring from appearing in any test/ examination or other evaluation process.
- Withholding results.
- Debarring from representing the institution in any regional, national or international meet, tournament, youth festival, etc.
- Suspension/ expulsion from the hostel.
- Cancellation of admission.
- Rustication from the institution for period ranging from one to four semesters.
- Expulsion from the institution and consequent debarring from admission to any other institution for a specified period.

Provided that where the persons committing or abetting the act of ragging are not identified, the institution shall resort to collective punishment.

CODE OF CONDUCT

Preamble :

This Code of Conduct establishes guidelines and standards of behavior for all faculty members, students, and non-teaching staff of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh College of Law, Amravati (the "College"). It aims to promote a safe, respectful, and ethical academic environment that fosters learning, personal growth, and mutual respect.

Short Title : This Policy shall be called and referred to as Code of Conduct Policy of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh College of Law.

Extent : This policy applies to all faculty members, students, and non-teaching staff of Dr. Panjabrao Deshmukh College of Law, Amravati.

Objective : The objective of this policy is to ensure adherence to the highest standards of professional conduct, integrity, and ethics by all members of the College community. It aims to create a positive and inclusive environment that upholds the values of respect, fairness, and personal responsibility.

Definitions :

Faculty Members : Refers to all individuals employed by the College in teaching or research positions.

Students : Refers to all individuals enrolled in law programs at the College.

Non-Teaching Staff : Refers to all individuals employed by the College in administrative, technical, or support roles who perform the duties other than that of teaching

TEACHERS / FACULTY MEMBERS CODE OF CONDUCT :

1. Teachers shall uphold the highest standards of professional conduct and ethics.
2. Teachers shall treat students with respect, fairness, and dignity, and shall not discriminate amongst students based on their race, gender, religion, or other personal characteristics.
3. Teachers shall prepare and deliver lectures and tutorials in a professional, informative, and engaging manner, and shall be accessible to students for academic and personal guidance and support.



4. Teachers shall maintain the confidentiality of students; academic and personal information and shall not disclose such information to unauthorized persons.
5. Teachers shall comply with the academic and administrative policies and guidelines of the UGC, Bar Council of India, State Government and College issued by them from time to time.

STUDENTS CODE OF CONDUCT :

1. Students shall uphold the highest standards of academic integrity and ethical conduct.
2. Students shall attend classes, tutorials, and other academic activities regularly and punctually, and shall complete assignments and examinations with honesty and diligence.
3. Students shall respect the dignity and rights of others, and shall not engage in any form of harassment, discrimination, or bullying.
4. Students shall maintain the cleanliness and safety of the College premises and facilities and shall not damage or misuse them.
5. Students shall comply with the academic and administrative policies and guidelines of the College.

NON-TEACHING STAFF CODE OF CONDUCT :

1. Non-teaching staff shall perform their duties with integrity, professionalism, and dedication.
2. Non-teaching staff shall treat faculty members, students, and other staff members with respect, fairness, and dignity, and shall not discriminate amongst them based on their race, gender, religion, or other personal characteristics.
3. Non-teaching staff shall maintain the cleanliness and safety of the College premises and facilities and shall promptly report any damage or misuse.
4. Non-teaching staff shall maintain the confidentiality of students' academic and personal information and shall not disclose such information to unauthorized persons.
5. Non-teaching staff shall comply with the administrative policies and guidelines of the College.
6. Non-teaching staff shall not misuse or misappropriate any of the College property or revenue.

DISCIPLINARY PROCEDURES :

1. Any violation of this Code of Conduct shall be subject to disciplinary action.
2. The disciplinary action shall be commensurate with the severity of the violation and may include warning, suspension, expulsion, termination of employment, or other appropriate action.
3. The disciplinary procedures shall be transparent, fair, and objective, and shall comply with the principles of natural justice and due process.

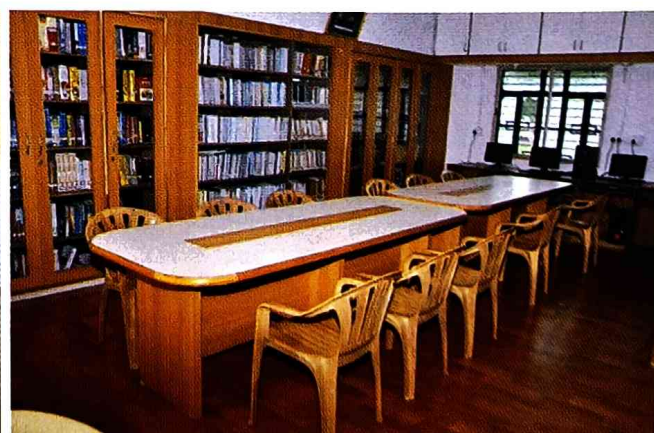
